Objective:

This assignment is designed to introduce students to the world of Capture The Flag (CTF) challenges through the CTF Cyber platform. Students will explore various cybersecurity puzzles and analyze each puzzle in the context of the CIA Triad (Confidentiality, Integrity, and Availability).

Instructions:

- 2. In your table groups, choose at least five puzzles that interest you. Some puzzles may be more difficult to solve using a Chromebook, so explore the site and find ones that can be solved using available resources. Feel free to use any and all tools necessary.
- 3. Solve each puzzle, and for each one, provide the following information:

Additionally, successful completion of the assignment involves submitting screenshots or written evidence of puzzle solutions.
